



Travel I-20 Request Form

In order to re-enter the United States after temporary international travel, F-1 students must possess a valid passport, a valid F-1 visa (unless exempt), and a valid Form I-20 with a current travel endorsement signature from a Designated School Official (DSO). Students planning to travel outside the United States must request a travel signature before departure.

Travel Signature Guidelines

Requests for a travel signature should be submitted at least 7 business days before the planned travel date. Travel signatures are generally valid for one year for enrolled F-1 students and six months for students participating in OPT or STEM OPT. Failure to obtain a valid travel signature before departure may result in delays or difficulties when re-entering the United States.

- Students on OPT or STEM OPT should ensure that their travel signature is valid within six months of their return to the United States.
- Travel signatures do not guarantee admission to the United States. Final admission is determined by U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) at the port of entry.
- Students are responsible for ensuring that all immigration documents remain valid throughout their travel period.
